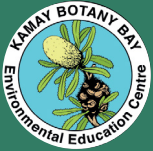


VIRTUAL STUDYTOURS



First Contacts at Kamay Botany Bay Stage 2: An International virtual lesson on Zoom

- Explore the events leading up to the first contact between the British and the Gweagal people.

- Step into the shoes of a botanist or botanical artist and create a botanic drawing just as Solander and Parkinson did in 1770.
